


BLIND DOG' WILLIE IN:




TO ACHIEVE A PERCEIVED DOUBLING OF LOUDNESS, JIM NEEDS

VOLUME.



HOWEVER, THE FLOOR MANAGER
WANTS BLIND DOG TO STAND
TWICE AS FAR FROM THE BREAKERS
THAN HE IS AT THE MOMENT.



JIMMY QUICKLY CALCULATES THAT IF BLIND DOG IS NOW TWICE AS FAR AWAY THERE WILL BE A REDUCTION IN BLIND DOG'S PERCEIVED VOLUME ... OF - 6 dB SPL. THE PERCEIVED LOUDNESS WILL BE HALF WHAT IT WAS ORIGINALLY.



SO, TO DOUBLE THE PERCEIVED SOUND SO IT IS 'JUST SO' FOR 'BLIND DOG'
JIMMY TIN NEEDS TO HAVE ONE HUNDRED SPEAKERS, ALL PLAYING AT
THE SAME VOLUME. NOW EVERYTHING IS SET, EVERYTHING'S READY TO GO...
